

Right Hand Page Template

Instructions

This works on the same principal as the cover template. **Black** for bleed, **blue** for slug, **white** for safe.

The new bit is the dashed red line. This is your clearance. As you're working on a perfect bound book there's a danger that things that are right in the middle will get lost in the spine when it's opened. Your readers would have to open the book really wide and risk cracking the spine, which is not ideal.

In an ideal world you'd keep anything crucial (text bubbles, people's faces etc) a bit away from the spine so that they can be easily seen.

The red line is there to show you the clearance of the spine. Just bear in mind that if anything inside the small white area bounded by this line is going to be tough to see without doing the book some major damage.

As ever, if you're worried about anything get in touch - it's easier to fix problems while they're happening than afterwards.
